Chapter 2 - Board of Trustees

BP 2431 SELECTION OF THE DISTRICT CHANCELLOR AND COLLEGE PRESIDENTS

The Board of Trustees shall designate a Board subcommittee to oversee the search process to fill the Chancellor position in the event of a vacancy. A search committee shall be formed which will include District stakeholders, including but not limited to constituency group representatives (including Academic Senate, Classified Senate, collective bargaining unit, and meet and confer unit members), and members of the community. The search committee shall make recommendations concerning all aspects of the search process.

The Board of Trustees will interview finalists in closed session.

The Board of Trustees shall direct the Chancellor to oversee the search process to fill the president position in the event of a vacancy. A search committee shall be formed which will include members District stakeholders, including but not limited to constituency group representatives, and members of the community. The search committee shall make recommendations concerning all aspects of the search process, which may include a campuswide forum for finalists, and shall recommend final candidates to the Chancellor.

The Chancellor will recommend at least two finalists for interview with the Board of Trustees and Chancellor in closed session. Following consultation with the full Board, the Chancellor shall select the President.

The search process(es) shall be fair, open, transparent, and shall comply with relevant regulations. The final selection will be announced in open session and voted on for approval pursuant to Title 5 Regulations and relevant Government Code sections.
