How do I retire from SDCCD?

How do I resign from SDCCD?

- You will need to fill out a separation notice and turn it in to your supervisor. Your supervisor will obtain the signatures needed and they will route it back to HR for processing. Please fill out [SDCCD's Separation Notice](#).

How do I transfer sick leave to/from SDCCD?

- **Transfer in:** please fill out SDCCD's sick leave transfer form and turn it in to your former employer. Here is SDCCD's [Sick Leave Transfer Form](#). Please email completed form to HRRetirement@sdccd.edu.
- **Transfer out:** please contact the HR department at the place where you want to transfer the sick leave to. They will have a sick leave transfer form that needs to be filled out by SDCCD. They can email the form to HRRetirement@sdccd.edu.

Please note: Before you can transfer your sick leave from SDCCD to different employer, you must resign from all of your positions at the District. You can resign from your position(s) by filling out the separation form linked [here](#).

Can I contribute more to CalSTRS/CalPERS?

- You may not contribute more towards your Defined Benefit Plan (CalSTRS/CalPERS), as contributions are fixed by law.

I am an Academic Adjunct promoted to Contract, do I still contribute to CalSTRS on future additional assignments?

- Yes. Any earnings from service that exceeds 1 year of service is credited toward your Defined Benefit Supplement (DBS) Program account.

How can I access the funds in my old Apple, Valic or NBS account?

- The administrator of your plan is now Schools First. They will be able to provide you information regarding your balance and what options are available to you. Schools First can be contacted at 800-462-8327 ext. 4727.

I am a CalPERS retiree. Can I work for SDCCD?

- At this time the District does not hire retired annuitants due to CalPERS regulations
