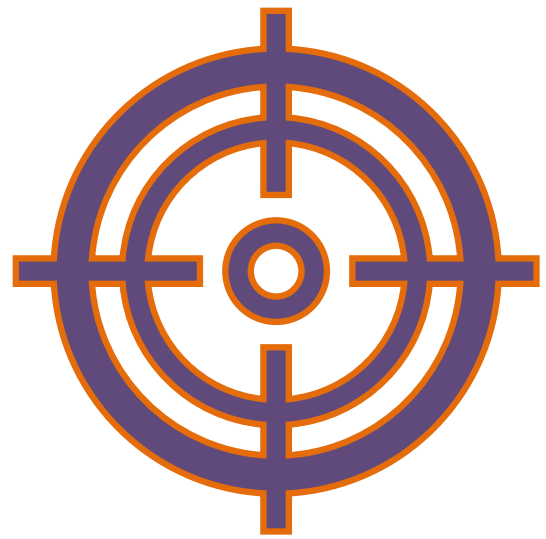


What is the Vision 2030

 - 12** Actions & demonstration projects

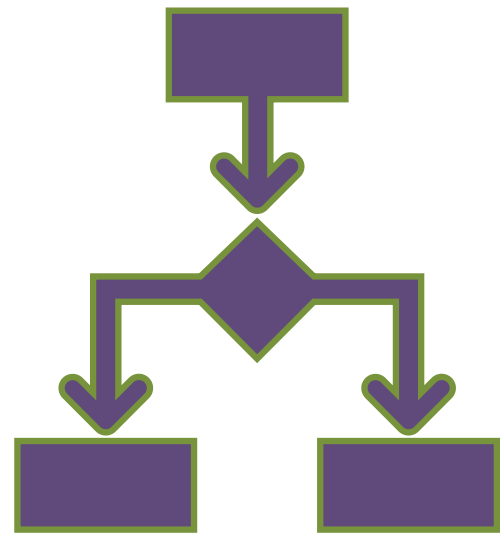

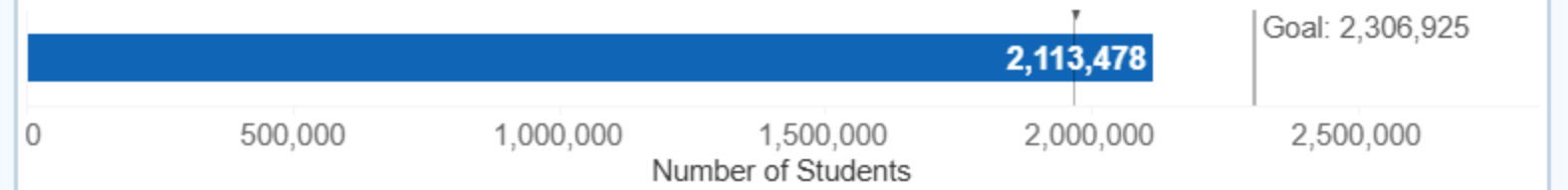

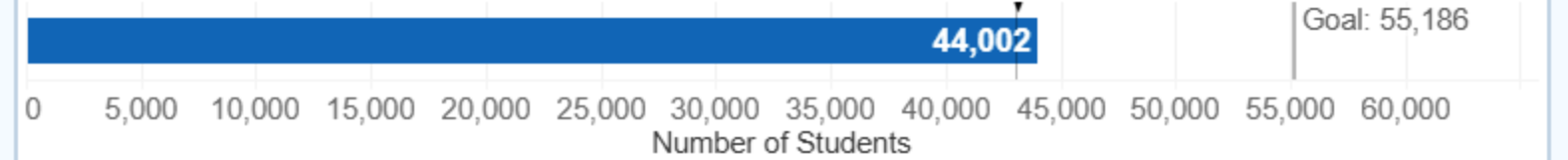

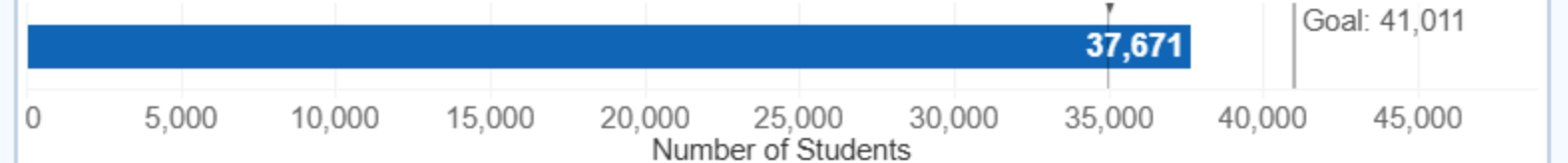

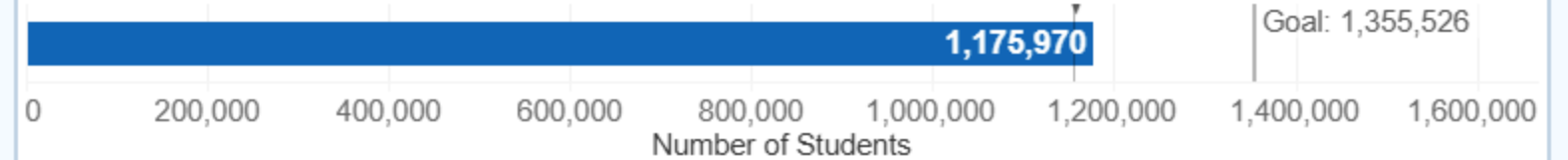

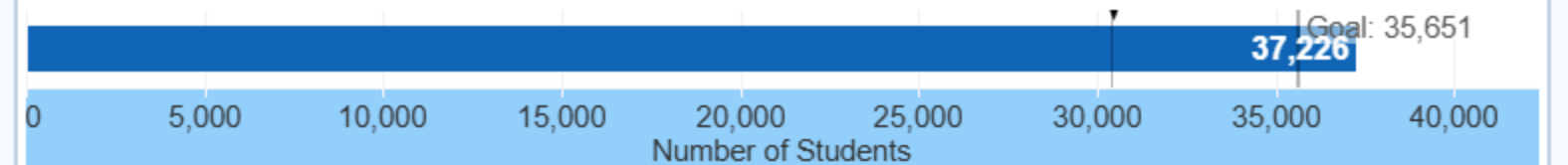

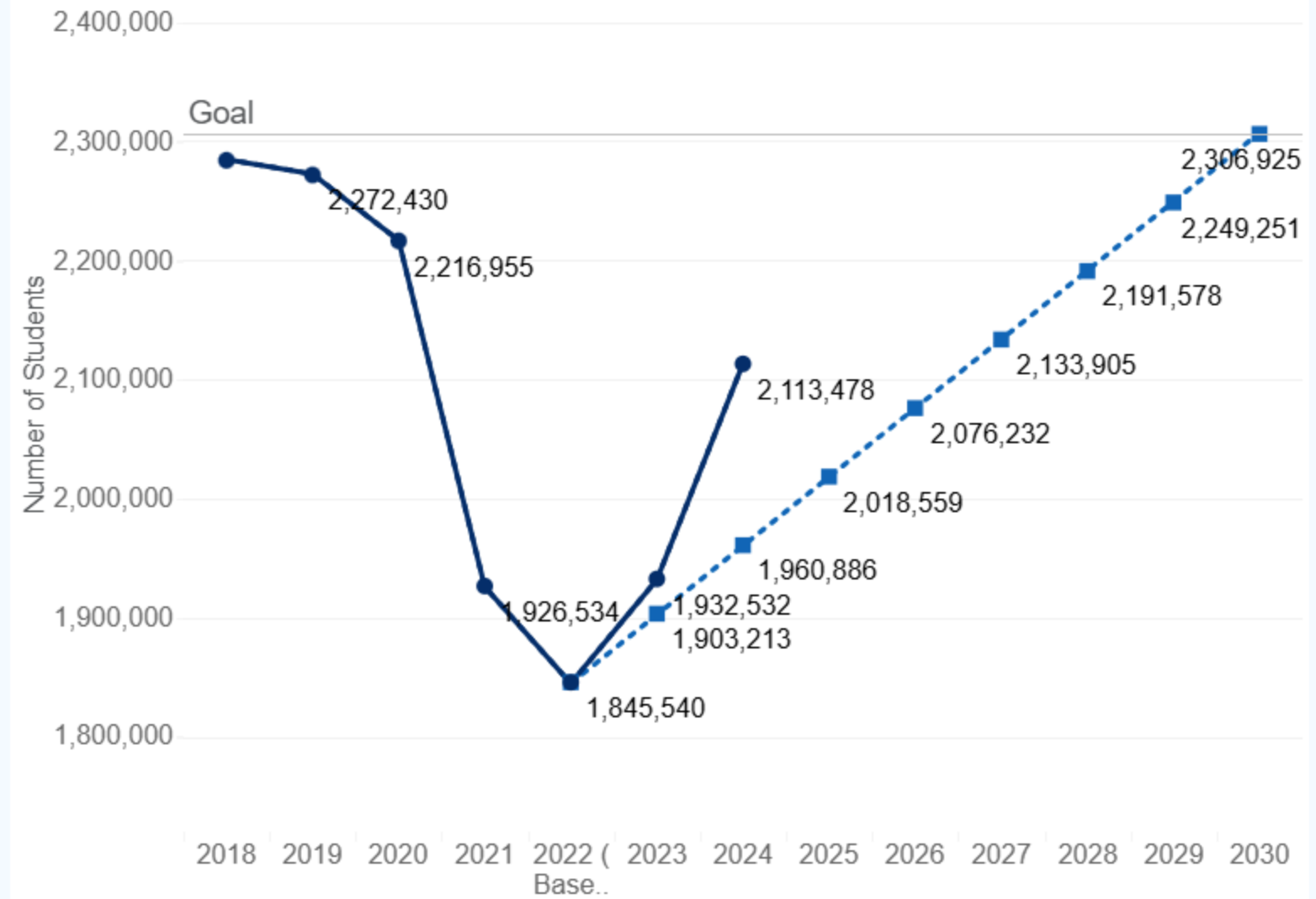

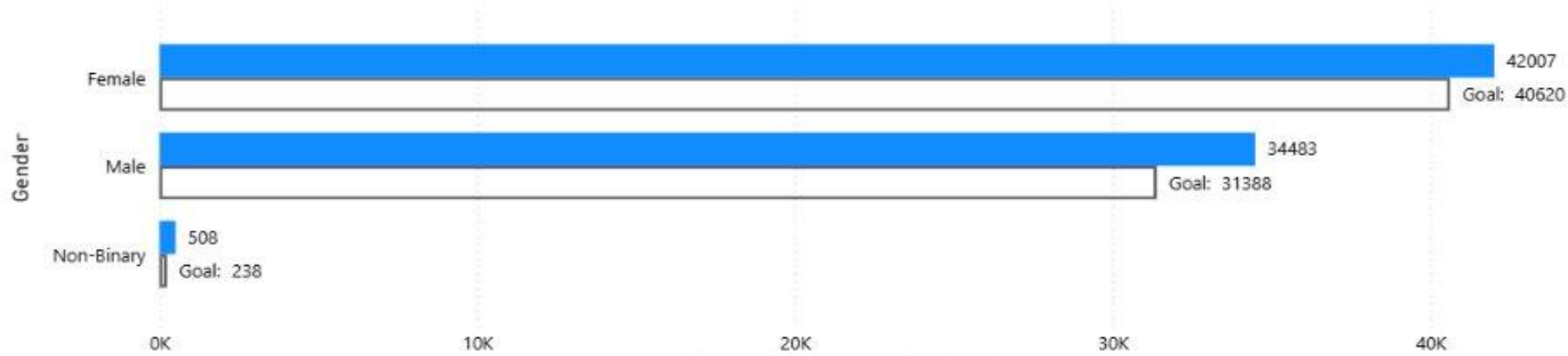

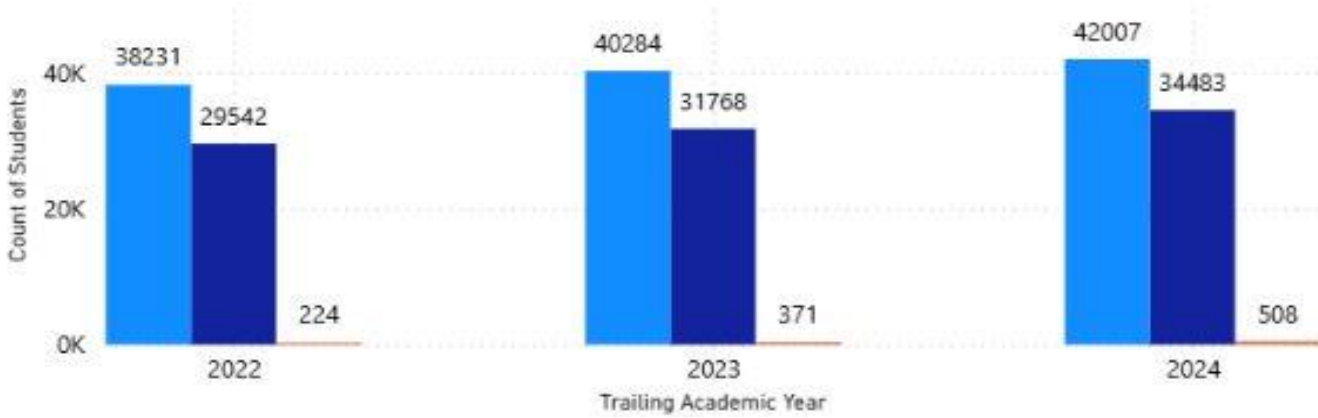
Students by Gender with Associated Goal

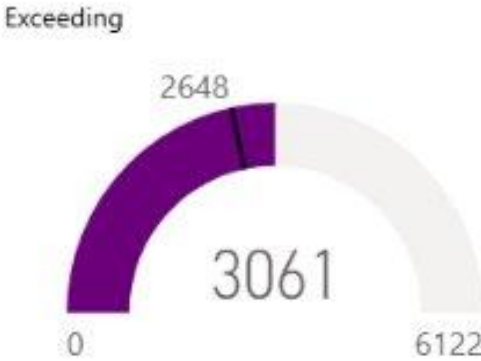

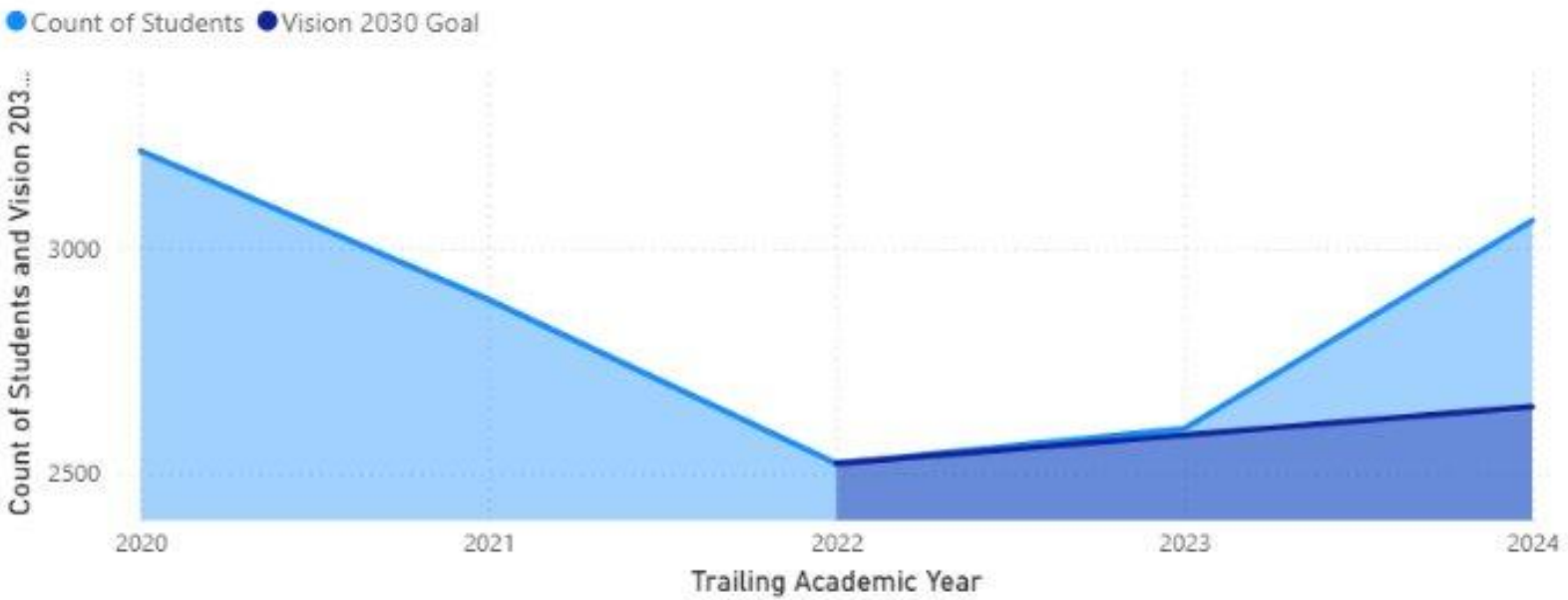
Transfer to CSU/UC



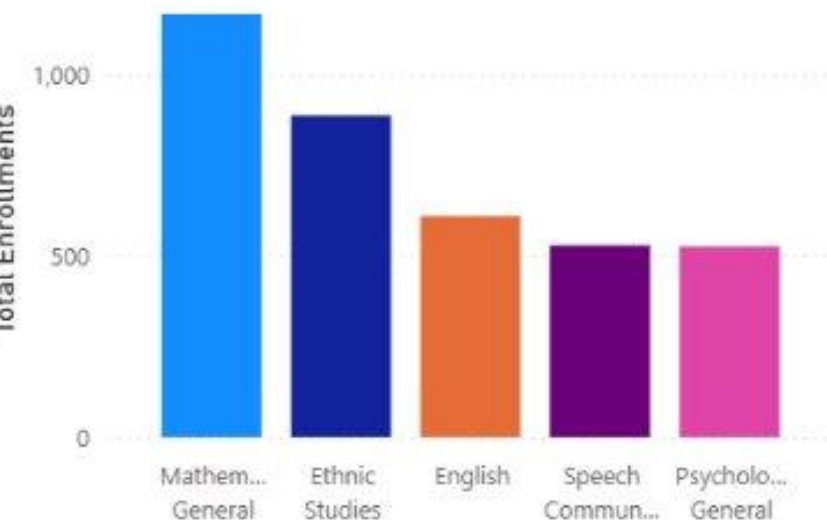
% of Transfers to CSU/UC



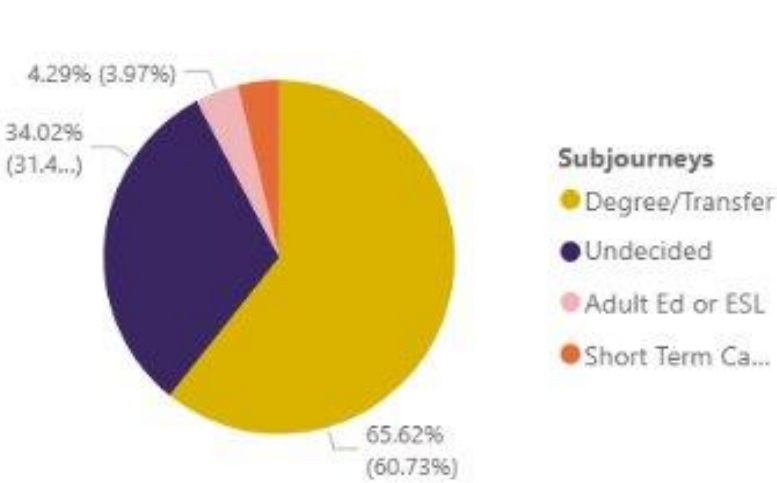
Actual and Goal Totals by Year
